gdump -- prints a gex graphic file

SYNOPSIS

gdump [file ...]

DESCRIPTION

Gdump prints a *gex*(1G) file in the format:

x, y, type, line style, [rotation/radius], [size], [symbol number], [text string]

Where *type* may be:

- J - jump
- V - vector
- T - text
- R - arc
- C - circle
- S - symbol
