

NAME

getafm – create an AFM file for a PostScript font.

SYNOPSIS

getafm *FontName* > *output.ps*

DESCRIPTION

Getafm generates a PostScript file which prints an AFM file for a font to the printer's output channel. The output of *getafm* should be sent to a printer, or to GhostScript. For example,

```
getafm Times-Roman | gsnd - >Times-Roman.afm
```
